RoHS Compliance

REACH Compliance declaration

Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (**REACH**) is a European Union regulation dated 18 December 2006. **REACH** addresses the production and use of chemical substances, and their potential impacts on both human health and the environment. CONFLICT MINERALS Statement

Under the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act, which was finalized in July 2010, publicly traded companies whose products contain metals derived from minerals defined as conflict minerals, which include tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold, are required to report annually to the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). The new reporting requirements are based on concerns that revenues obtained from mining and transport of conflict minerals finance the ongoing conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries and the resulting humanitarian crisis.
